

Authorization to Use and Disclose Protected Health Information (PHI)

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INTRODUCTION

I have had the opportunity to read Brandon Gynecology Associates, P.A.'s HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices regarding the use and disclosure of protected health information (PHI). I understand that the practice does not need written patient authorization to securely release information related to Treatment, Payment and Operations (TPO). For example, I do not need to provide written permission to release information to a referring physician, insurance carrier or software vendor that is responsible for claims processing.

I also understand that I have choices regarding the authorization of Brandon Gynecology Associates, PA to release private information to designated individuals when necessary, as in the case of an emergency. For example, I may give the practice permission to release specific information to family members or friends. Details are listed below.

- Should I authorize such release of information, I may specify both the names of the individuals and the information that can/cannot be released.
- My signature is required in order to complete the request.
- Brandon Gynecology Associates, P.A. may use and disclose my PHI only until the expiration date or event relating to me for the specific purpose of the use or disclosure. This authorization is not a blanket permission to use and disclose PHI for an unlimited time period.
- I understand that PHI used or disclosed pursuant to this authorization may be subject to re-disclosure by the recipient of the information. At that point, the PHI may no longer be protected under federal or state confidentiality rules.
- At all times, I retain the right to revoke this authorization to use and disclose PHI. Should I wish to exercise this right, I will submit a written request to the Brandon Gynecology Associates Practice Administrator.
- I understand that Brandon Gynecology Associates, P.A. may charge a fee for copying the medical records for which I have provided authorization for use and disclosure.

If I choose not to authorize Brandon Gynecology Associates, P.A. to release my PHI to specific individuals and/or I choose not to sign this form, my decision will in no way affect my treatment, payment, enrollment in a health plan or eligibility for benefits.
